The **New Science Teacher of the Year Award** is given by the ASTA to recognize and honor a science teacher who demonstrated during his/her first year outstanding potential for a life of quality science teaching. This award is given each year and is presented at the annual ASTA convention. Nominees must meet the following criteria to be eligible for this award: (1) completed a first (i.e., rookie) year of teaching; (2) hold a valid Arizona teaching certificate; (3) be a full-time classroom teacher at either the elementary, middle school, or high school level; and (4) be a member of the Arizona Science Teachers Association.
