The goal of this degree is to promote healthy behaviors in the general population through community interventions.

Milestone Requirements

Students in the public health program are required to meet specific criteria to be eligible for certain upper division coursework. Enforcement will occur through a prerequisite milestone requirement for the following HS courses:

HS 390w, 402, 403, 404, & 408c.

Public Health milestone requirements are as follows:

- have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- have completed 36 units of coursework
- have completed 15 units of liberal studies coursework in discipline studies with a grade point average of at least 2.5
- have completed HS 200 with a grade of B or higher ^{"C" or better}
- have completed HS 205 with a grade of C or higher ^{"C" or better}
- have a grade of B or higher in the most recent English foundations coursework (ENG 105 or equivalent) ^{"C" or better}

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~~If you don't meet this requirement, you may take an approved writing course at the 200 level or higher to replace an English foundations course to achieve the 3.0 requirement. You can be enrolled in HS 200 and HS 205 at time of application; however, these courses must be completed with a grade of B or better to be eligible for the milestone. This degree progression plan is to be used in conjunction with the academic catalog and degree progress report. Students should see an academic advisor regularly to confirm their academic progress.~~

Students must see an academic advisor before enrollment for the 7th term in preparation for graduation. Submit graduation application during 7th term.

Honors students complete different requirements to meet NAU's liberal studies program. Students should consult an Honors Program advisor for complete information on fulfilling Honors Liberal Studies requirements.

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- HS 408C is a capstone experience requiring application of program content in a community setting. All other major requirements must be completed prior to enrolling in HS 408C.
