For the B.S.Ed. degree, you must have the following:

- a grade of "B" or better for the English foundation requirement (ENG 105 or equivalent) (If you do not receive a "B," you may complete an additional writing course, at the 200 level or above, with a "B" or better, to meet this requirement.)
- a grade of at least C for the mathematics foundation requirement (generally MAT 110, 114, 125, or 155)

Students may only take lower-level GER courses if you have not already taken advanced GER coursework. For instance, after you have completed 200-level GER courses, you cannot take GER courses at the 100 level; after completing 300-level courses, you cannot take 100 or 200 level courses.

Students must earn a grade of C or better in any course they wish to apply towards their major in German.

Students are expected to pass the Zertifikat Deutsch als Fremdsprache exam with a score of gut or better before completing their undergraduate degree.
