- Student Qualifications:**
- Be an enrolled member of the Navajo or Hopi Nation;
 - Attending a two or four-year college/university in Arizona, New Mexico, Colorado, or Utah;
 - Have a declared major or special degree program;
 - Entering your junior or senior year in fall 2009, or entering the second year of a two-year college program;
 - Have a 3.0 GPA or better.

Your letter of application should include a narrative description of:

- 1) your degree program;
- 2) your career plans;
- 3) how your educational goals relate to the Navajo or Hopi Nation;
- 4) a copy of your census card or proof of tribal enrollment;
- 5) your social security number
- 6) your address while at school and your home address, plus a contact phone number;
- 7) certification of enrollment from your educational institution that indicates your status in school as of the end of the spring semester 2009 and your current GPA.

The scholarships will be announced at the Native American Arts Auction at Hubbell Trading Post National Historic Site in September 2009. Friends of Hubbell Trading Post National Historic Site, Inc. is a non-profit charitable organization incorporated in the state of Arizona.
