Students may only take lower-level FRE courses if you have not already taken advanced FRE coursework. For instance, after you've completed 200-level GER courses, you can't take FRE courses at the 100 level; after completing 300-level courses you can't take 100 or 200 level courses.

Students must earn a grade of C or better in any course they wish to apply towards their major in German.
