***Students may take a 24-unit emphasis in such areas as Asian humanities, business, cultural studies, environmental humanities, European humanities, film, foreign service, Latin American humanities, public humanities, pre-law, and Southwest humanities. You must work with your advisor to determine the courses you will use for this student-individualized plan as early as possible to ensure that you graduate in a timely fashion. Please be aware that your advisor must approve these 24 units of coursework.
