PROGRAM INFORMATION

Students may not use TH prefix courses to meet any liberal studies requirements.

Students must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 in their major.

Also be aware that, for the B.S.Ed. degree, you must have the following:

- a grade of at least B for the English foundation requirement (ENG 105 or equivalent)
(If you don't receive a 3.0, you may complete an additional writing course, at the 200 level or above, with at least a B, to meet this requirement.)
- a grade of at least C for the math foundation requirement (generally MAT 110, 114, 125, or 155)

If you wish to obtain this optional endorsement to teach creative drama in Arizona elementary schools, you must also take the following 6 units: ECI 302 and TH 315 or 345. (Because this endorsement is optional, these units aren't included in the 131 units described for this degree.)

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All students are required to complete at least 120 total units which includes:
