## **PROGRAM INFORMATION**

Be aware that, for the B.S.Ed. degree, you must have the following:

- a grade of at least B for the English foundation requirement (ENG 105 or equivalent) (If you don't receive a 3.0, you may complete an additional writing course, at the 200 level or above, with at least a B, to meet this requirement.)
- a grade of at least C for the mathematics foundation requirement (generally MAT 110, 114, 125, or 155)

\*This course is required for Arizona certification, not graduation. May be waived by examination.

\*\*FRE Elective excluding FRE 101 & 102.

\*\*\* Students may substitute FRE 421 and 422 for FRE 405 and 406 with their advisor's consent.

Students may not use FRE prefix courses to meet any liberal studies requirements.

Students may only take lower-level FRE courses if you have not already taken advanced FRE coursework. For instance, after you've completed 200-level FRE courses, you can't take FRE courses at the 100 level; after completing 300-level courses you can't take 100 or 200 level courses.

Students must earn a grade of C or better in any course they wish to apply towards their major in French..

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Honors students complete different requirements to meet NAU's liberal studies program. Students should consult an Honors Program advisor for complete information on fulfilling Honors Liberal Studies requirements.
- All students are required to complete at least 120 total units which includes:
