The students at Northern Arizona University value their faculty. Whether it is sophomores, graduating seniors, or alumni, students consistently rate their satisfaction with the quality of NAU's faculty above ninety-five percent. For the past four years, the Office of Planning, Budget, and Institutional Research has conducted an annual Sophomore Survey. In this survey students are asked *“If any member of the NAU faculty or staff has positively influenced your experience at NAU, please complete the following information.”* Students are then asked to provide a name, department and comment. The following is a summary of the data collected on this one question; and the attached report lists all the comments from the students regarding faculty and staff.

Out of the 724 students that participated in the 2007 sophomore survey, 425 students (59%) provided one or more names of a faculty or staff member that has positively influenced their experience at NAU. The table below summarizes the names and departments of the six faculty / staff members that were acknowledged the most by the 2007 sophomore class.

While most of the complements were for faculty and academic areas, acknowledgement was also given to non-instructional areas such as Dining, Distance Learning, Fronske, Gateway, Honors, and Residence Life (among others).

Numerous comments were regarding faculty / staff members who are approachable, caring, dedicated, and excited about their subject matter. Several comments were related to how a faculty member had gotten the student so enthusiastic about course material that they looked forward to each class. Many faculty / staff were recognized for providing career advice and being positive role models. Several students credited a faculty or staff member for assisting them with finding solutions to personal problems that allowed them to stay in school.

The Office of Planning, Budget and Institutional Research has been reporting on this question since 2004 resulting in four years of student comments. Deserving particular accolade are the 20 faculty / staff members who have been mentioned by at least one student each year of this study. These 20 faculty members and their departments are listed on page 4 of this report.
