APPLICATION PRIORITY DATES

All students are encouraged to apply as soon as possible. Students who apply early get consideration for scholarships. You can apply at the end of your junior year in high school.

Fall semester application:	February 1
Spring semester application:	December 1
Summer application:	May 1

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- An official high school transcript in a sealed envelope sent directly from the high school or in the same envelope with the application. Submitting both the application and transcript in the same envelope will expedite an admission decision.
- ACT and/or SAT scores. You should indicate NAU as a score recipient when you register for either test. NAU ACT code: 0086; NAU SAT code: 4006. Test scores posted to your official high school transcript are acceptable.

FRESHMAN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All students applying for admission must meet both the General Aptitude and coursework requirements. For full details see www.nau.edu/uadmissions.

Arizona residents will be **admitted** if they meet the following:

- 3.00 or higher core GPA* (on a 4.0 scale), or a 22 ACT or 1040 SAT score, or top 25 percent class rank and have no deficiencies in the required coursework.

Arizona residents will be **considered** for admission if they meet the following:

- 2.50-2.99 core GPA* (on a 4.0 scale) or top 50 percent class rank, and have no more than one deficiency in any two subject areas in the coursework requirements. Students with a combination math/lab science deficiency are not admissible.

Nonresident students will be **admitted** if they meet the following:

- 3.00 or higher core GPA* (on a 4.0 scale) or 24 ACT or 1110 SAT score or top 25 percent class rank and have no deficiencies in the coursework requirements.

Nonresident students will be **considered** for admission based on individual circumstances and/or space availability if they meet the following:

- 2.50-2.99 core GPA* (on a 4.0 scale) or top 50 percent class rank and have no more than one deficiency in any two subject areas in the coursework requirements. Students with a combination math/lab science deficiency are not admissible.

COURSEWORK REQUIREMENTS

4 units of English	4 units of Math
3 units of Lab Science	2 units of Social Studies
2 units of Foreign Language	1 unit of Fine Arts

Home schooled and charter school applicants meet aptitude requirements through ACT or SAT composite test scores. ACT score of 22 (Arizona resident) or 24 (non-resident) or SAT I score of 1040 (Arizona resident) or 1110 (non-resident). Coursework descriptions must be met through test scores.

GED applicants: Must submit an official score report from the applicable state department of education and must have a minimum composite score of 50.

***Core GPA is calculated using only the 16 required core courses (see coursework requirements)**
