- Faxed materials cannot be accepted as official documents.

All students are encouraged to apply as soon as possible. Students who apply early receive consideration for scholarships. We will continue to accept applications as long as space is available.

- An official high school transcript** in a sealed envelope sent directly from the high school or in the same envelope as the application to NAU's Office of Undergraduate Admissions at PO Box 4084, Flagstaff, AZ 86011-4084. Submitting both the application and the transcript in the same envelope will expedite the admission decision.
- ACT and/or SAT scores.** You should indicate NAU as a score recipient when you register for either test. (Please note: the essay portion of either the ACT or SAT will not be considered in the admissions decision process.)
NAU ACT code: 0086; NAU SAT code: 4006. Test scores posted to your official high school transcript are accepted.

FRESHMAN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All students applying for admission must meet both the General Aptitude and coursework requirements. For full details, see www.nau.edu/uadmissions.

ARIZONA RESIDENTS:

Arizona residents will be **offered** admission if they meet the following: 3.00 or higher core GPA* (on a 4.0 scale), or a 22 ACT score, or a combined verbal and math only score of 1040 on the SAT, or top 25 percent class rank and have no deficiencies in the required college preparatory courses (listed at right) only.

Arizona residents will be **considered** for admission if they meet the following: 2.50-2.99 core GPA* (on a 4.0 scale) or top 50 percent class rank, and have no more than one deficiency in any two subject areas in the required college preparatory courses (listed at right). Students with both a math and lab science deficiency are not admissible.

NON-RESIDENTS:

Non-resident students will be **offered** admission if they meet the following: 3.00 or higher core GPA* (on a 4.0 scale), or a 24 ACT score, or a combined verbal and math only score of 1110 on the SAT, or top 25 percent class rank and have no deficiencies in the required college preparatory courses (listed at right).

Non-residents will also be **offered** admission if they have a 2.50 or higher GPA (on a 4.0 scale) in at least 24 transferable college credits **and** if they have completed all college preparatory courses (listed at right).

Non-resident students will be **considered** for admission based on individual circumstances and/or space availability if they meet the following: 2.50-2.99 core GPA* (on a 4.0 scale) or top 50 percent class

rank and have no more than one deficiency in any two subject areas in the required college preparatory courses (listed at right). Students with both a math and lab science deficiency are not admissible.

COLLEGE PREPARATORY COURSES:

- 4 years of college preparatory English
- 4 years of Math, including Algebra I & II, Geometry and any advanced math course for which Algebra II is a prerequisite
- 3 years of laboratory Science – one in three of the four areas of Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Earth Science
- 2 years of Social Science – one year must be American History
- 2 years of one Foreign Language
- 1 year of Fine Arts

Home schooled and charter school applicants meet aptitude requirements through ACT or SAT composite test scores. ACT score of 22 (Arizona resident) or 24 (non-resident) or SAT score of 1040 (Arizona resident) or 1110 (non-resident). Note: only the math and verbal portions of the SAT will be used when processing test scores for admissions.

GED applicants must submit an official score report from the applicable state department of education and must have a minimum composite score of 50.

* **Core GPA is calculated using only the 16 required core courses listed in the Coursework Requirements above.**
